Would you like to learn to sail? Are you a sailor and want to learn new skills?

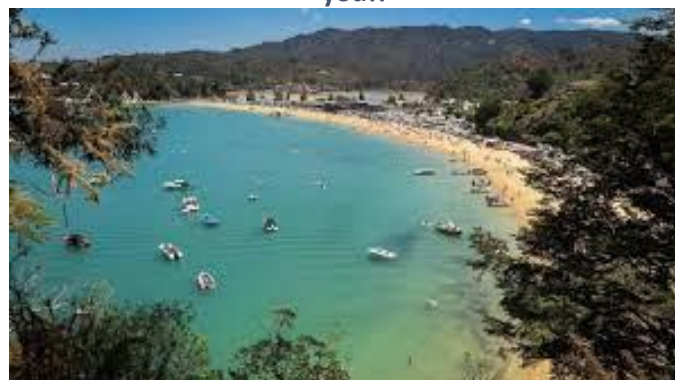
